

SHADE STRUCTURES FOR MITCHELTON HIGH MALL AREA

The Gambling Community Benefit Fund was established to assist community groups throughout Queensland. It was appreciated by all in our Mitchelton Community that the Fund recognised the need in the school and the important role played by organisations such as the Mitchelton State High School P&C Association and therefore granted funds for the building of four shade structures in our mall area.



With the extremes of climates that are experienced in Queensland, there is a need for structures that students and the community can use as protection from these conditions.

With the funding provided, the Mitchelton community was able to install colourbond metal shade structures. The installation of a rolled arch structure over existing outdoor furniture together with two structures over bench seating provided a much needed resource for all. This was complimented by a sloped skillion roofed structure that provides students with an area protected from the elements for them to sit and use as a walkway to their classroom areas.
