Considerations

Performance	

Students who have an interest in arts (FTM, Visual Arts) or technical subjects (CAD, coding) may need to consider higher specifications

- Higher power processor current generation Intel i5 / Ryzen 5 or higher
- RAM 8GB, 16GB (Recommended) or higher
- The most recent generation devices tend to allow for longer run times/performance when operating on battery

Functionality

To best utilise currently available technologies, you may wish to consider some of these optional features

- Front facing camera
- Stylus/Touch screen input
- Multiple USB ports
- HDMI/Video output

Portability

Consider the total weight of the device, especially if your student is walking or commuting on public transport

Aim for a device with a lower weight ideally around 1.6Kg or lighter

Durability

As with all technology there is a chance of damage occurring. It may be worth considering a device which offers greater durability.

- Consider adding an extended warranty which covers accidental damage to the device.
- Sturdy build quality
- Spill-proof keyboard

Further BYO requirements

- Students should keep their laptops in a case or sleeve for greater protection
- A pair of wired headphones which best fit your student should be purchased
- While not mandatory, it is recommended that a students BYO device be covered by an insurance policy which covers loss, damage or theft at school and off grounds.

Software Notes

- An extra antivirus package should not be required for Windows devices as the default Windows Defender package is very capable when kept up to date. If you are using a MacOS device, you will require an antivirus solution, free options should be fine when kept updated.
- Microsoft Office is available to all users on the education department's network, it is not necessary to purchase this software separately
- Adobe Creative Cloud will be available to install for those students completing relevant courses
- Students will need an administrator account on their device to connect to the school network
