### This funding will be used to

Continue our commitment to **Successful** and **Engaged** learners by:

- Improving academic data across Year 7 -10 with >85% A-C in Maths, Science, English and Humanities
- Extending students in the A-B range >25% A-B in Maths, Science, English and Humanities
- Improving NAPLAN results with >25% U2B in reading, writing and numeracy
- Improving attendance rates >95% across the school

### Our initiatives include

- Review and publication of a quality Junior Curriculum and Assessment Plan
- Development of sequential units of study in preparation for the implementation of the new Senior Syllabus
- Strengthening the implementation of REAP to effectively deliver the curriculum
- A focus on writing in all classrooms

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Continuing professional development for teachers in planning, implementing and assessing the curriculum
- Providing professional learning for teachers in the effective delivery of the curriculum - pedagogy
- Providing professional development for teachers and teacher aides in writing
- Tracking, monitoring and supporting identified students at risk
- Peer coaching for all academic staff and mentoring of beginning and new teachers

Funding:

• Additional staff to provide support for identified students e.g. EALD and Learning Support	\$90,000
• Professional learning and planning time for staff to develop and implement high quality programs	\$26,589
• Purchase of data tracking and support programs – PAT R, PAT N, Mathematics	\$5,500
• Provision of wide reading and writing resources for classroom use	\$50,000
