

# TRADE PATHWAYS

## FULL-TIME & FUNDED COMPRESSED SENIOR WITH TRADE FOCUS



Students commencing Year 11 in 2027 may apply to participate in an accelerated senior program focused on developing a trade-based pathway, aligned with the student's interests and strengths.

Students will complete a program of compressed senior English and Maths, and additional qualifications including their trade preparation program or school-based apprenticeship to attain at least 20 QCE credits over the 38-week program (one school year). This program is a partnership between Brisbane North West Trade Training Centre and Mitchelton State High School, as well as our industry-standard RTOs.

In addition, students will complete Certificate III New Business & Entrepreneurship (BSB303220), selected to provide students with a wide range of business skills relevant to sole traders.

Students who have already completed a Cert II trade qualification can apply and commit to attaining a school-based apprenticeship or employment in a relevant business context.
