Achieve the following whole school targets aligned to the school's AIP 2020:

Literacy and Numeracy

- 90% of Year 7 students "at or above" National Minimum Standard in writing (NAPLAN)
- 80% of Year 9 students "at or above" National Minimum Standard (NAPLAN)
- Year 7 & 9 Mean Scale Scores in Reading and Writing above the school's ICSEA percentile of 36 (NAPLAN)

Academic Achievement

- Year 7 & 8 : 90% A-C & 40% A-B
- Year 9 : 85% A-C & 40% A-B
- Year 10: 85% A-C & 50% A-B
- Year 11: 85% A-C & 40% A-B
- Year 12: 85% A-C & 35% A-B

Engagement

- 10% decrease in Student disciplinary Absences (as measured by short term suspensions)
- 15% staff improvement in the School Opinion Survey item "managing behaviour" to 85%
- 90% overall attendance rate
- 20% attendance rate <85% (26.6% in 2019)

- Continue the implementation of a whole school writing program (WTE).
- Strengthen co-operative planning in the implementation of WTE
- Targeted teaching using MSHS's pedagogical practices (REAP) and whole school Data strategies.
- Continue to prioritise staff collaboration to plan in professional learning teams on the development of a quality AC and SATE curricula; REAP strategies and data informed practices

Build teacher capacity through:

- Positive Behaviour Learning skilling
- Common Classroom Practice as informed by Effective Skills in Classroom Management and Profiling
- Continued focus on strategies to improve attendance
- The Berry Street Education Model
- Further development of a Case management approach to data (Lyn Sharratt "Putting FACES on the Data")
